

DAYCAMP AT SEACAMP 2025

Daycamp for Kids ages 10-13

- Winter Break Camp: December 30, 2024 to January 3, 2025
- Spring Break Camp: March 17 to 21, 2025

Cost: \$350.00 per week (Lunch is provided)

IN THE MORNING:

All campers should arrive at camp between 8:30 and 8:45 am. Program begins at 9:00 am. Campers should arrive by private car. Please park at the end of the paved road at the turn around and be walked into the first trailer on the right by the entrance of the property. **Campers must be signed in by authorized adults** on the sign-in sheet in the Daycamp trailer. Campers may not ride bicycles, walk, or take a boat to camp by themselves.

AT THE END OF THE DAY:

Campers may be picked up at the Daycamp trailer between 5:00 – 5:30 pm. **An authorized adult must be present to sign them out with ID verification.**

WHAT TO BRING:

Most of the day will be spent in swimsuits and t-shirts. Campers should plan to bring the following items to camp daily (including the first day). Please put camper's name on all items brought to camp.



In gym bag:

In dive bag:

Snorkel
Snorkel Mask (Tempered glass)

Personal Flotation Device (Type III PFD)
Wetsuit (optional)

Items NOT Allowed:

Pets
Knives
Fireworks
Electronic Games
Spray Sunscreen

Note: We can make arrangements Monday morning to purchase a Seacamp reusable water bottle. Mask, fins, snorkel and PFD may be left at camp during the week and are kept in a locked box when not in use. The camp is not responsible for articles of clothing or personal belongings lost or damaged. We recommend that campers do not bring valuables such as expensive watches, cell phones, cameras, or any other electronic devices. Our Ship's Store will be open during the week for campers to purchase a variety of items such as t-shirts, mugs, souvenirs, and ice cream.

Campfire: One night each week, Daycamp at Seacamp hosts a campfire for all daycampers and any family and friends they would like to bring. Campfire starts at 8:00 pm and ends around 9:00 pm, with campers performing songs and skits they have learned and practiced during the week and concludes with the making of s'mores. The day of the campfire varies each week and will be announced to you at the beginning of the week your child attends.
